NOTICE OF TECHNICAL CONFERENCE

Entergy Mississippi, LLC ("Entergy Mississippi" or "EML") files this Notice of Technical Conference ("Technical Conference" or "Conference") pursuant to the Mississippi Public Service Commission's Rule 29: Integrated Resource Planning and Reporting.

- 1. On November 22, 2019, the Mississippi Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued its Final Order Amending Rule 29 to Establish Integrated Resource Planning and Annual Energy Delivery Reporting Requirements. The issuance of the Final Order triggered the provisions of Rule 29.105.3, requiring each electric utility subject to Rule 29 to "notice and conduct a technical conference for those interested parties that have executed a nondisclosure agreement in accordance with Section 108 of this Rule" no later than 45 days prior to the utility filing its Integrated Resource Plan ("IRP").
- 2. On December 23, 2019, EML filed its Notice of IRP Cycle. EML requested to modify the compliance schedule prescribed in Rule 29, in part to extend the date by which EML would conduct its Conference. On January 6, 2020, the Commission issued an order granting EML's request for a modified compliance schedule, directing EML to hold its Conference no later than May 1, 2021.
- EML will conduct its Technical Conference on Monday, April 19, 2021, between the hours of 10:00am – 12:00pm central. Due to the continuing risks posed by the

COVID-19 virus, EML will conduct the Conference **remotely**. Entergy Mississippi will host the meeting using Cisco WebEx Meetings, which supports an online option and a dial-in option. Interested parties that have executed a nondisclosure agreement and wish to attend the Conference should **em**ail Entergy Mississippi's representative at <u>ahall4@entergy.com</u> and provide your name, the organization you represent, and the email address where the WebEx invitation should be sent. Entergy Mississippi will send participants a calendar invitation by email, which will include a link and instructions to log into the WebEx platform.
