On January 6, 2011, the Mississippi Public Service Commission (Commission) issued its Order Establishing Docket and established a docket regarding its intent to investigate the possibility of establishing and implementing net metering and interconnection standards for Mississippi.

As of December 2010, 46 states and the District of Columbia have enacted net metering programs that can be accessed by its citizens. This policy standardizes the opportunities for individuals and businesses to invest in the renewable energy market and reduce the demand for fuels like natural gas and coal that are used to generate electricity. This policy allows consumers to offset a portion of their overall electricity use with electricity generated from on-site renewable resources, such as biomass, biogas, wind, solar, and fuel cells. As an advocate for energy sustainability and diversification in the electric and gas utility marketplace and as a utility ratepayer, I request acknowledgement from the Commission to intervene as a party in this docket.
