MOTION TO RECUSE COMMISSIONER LYNN POSEY

COMES NOW Intervener Thomas A. Blanton and brings this Motion to Recuse Commissioner Lynn Posey, and in support of this Motion, Blanton sets forth the following facts, to-wit:

1. That on October 1, 2013 at Tico's in Jackson, Mississippi and on October 8, 2013 at Weidmann's in Meridian, Mississippi coordinated fund raisers were held for Public Service Commissioner Lynn Posey. The sponsors of both events were "Chairmen" and "Hosts." A copy of the Invitation to both fund raisers is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."
2. The "Chairmen" of the two fund raising events were Devinney Construction Company, Jean and Tom Elmore, Eutaw Construction Company, Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians, Puckett Machinery/Puckett Rents, and Nancy and Bill Yates. A copy of documents filed as discovery responses by Mississippi Power Company in MPSC Docket

NO. 2015-UN-0080 is attached hereto as Exhibit "B." This Exhibit shows that Eutaw Construction Company provided services to Mississippi Power Company at the Kemper County IGCC Plant and/or mine in 2013 and was paid a total by Mississippi Power Company of Two Million Seven Hundred Thousand Seven Hundred Eighteen Dollars and ninety-three cents (\$2,700,718.93); that Puckett Machinery Company provided services at Kemper County IGCC Plant and/or mine in 2013 and was paid by Mississippi Power Company at total of Eight Million Three Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and seventy-four cents (\$8,364,868.74); that Puckett Rents provided services at the Kemper County IGCC Plant and/or mine in 2013 and was paid by Mississippi Power Company at total of One Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Seven Dollars and seventy-six cents (\$129,247.76); that Yates Construction Company provided services at the Kemper County IGCC Plant and/or mine in 2013 and was paid a total by Mississippi Power Company of Fifty-Four Million, One Hundred Thirty-Seven Thousand, Twenty-Seven Dollars and ninety-five cents (\$54,127,027.95).

3. Commissioner Posey's campaign contribution filing with the Mississippi Secretary of State for 2013 (Ex. "C") shows contributions which included the following: Business Interiors, Magnolia Steel Company, Engineering Plus, Inc., Puckett Machinery Company and Tommy Dulaney, President of Structural Steel Services, Inc. (Exhibit "D"). Exhibit "B" shows that Puckett Machinery Company provided services at the Kemper County IGCC Plant and/or mine in 2013 as set forth *supra*. Exhibit "B" also shows that Business

Interiors provided services at the Kemper County IGCC Plant and/or mine during 2013 and was paid a total by Mississippi Power Company of One Hundred Ten Thousand Seven Hundred Four Dollars and ninety-two cents (\$110,704.92); that Magnolia Steel Company provided services at the Kemper County IGCC Plant and/or mine in 2013 and was paid a total Five Hundred Forty-One Thousand Nine Hundred Five Dollars and twenty-eight cents (\$541,905.28); that Southern Pipe and Supply provided services at the Kemper County IGCC Plant and/or mine in 2013 and was paid a total by Mississippi Power Company of Eight Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars and thirty-six cents (\$845,583.36); that Engineering Plus, Inc. provided services at the Kemper County IGCC Plant and/or mine in 2013 and was paid a total by Mississippi Power Company of One Hundred Nine Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Seven Dollars and eighty-five cents (\$195,587.85); that Structural Steel Services, Inc. provided services at the Kemper County IGCC Plant and/or mine in 2013 and was paid a total by Mississippi Power Company of Ten Million Two Hundred Six Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Two Dollars and thirty-seven cents (\$10,206,182.37).

4. Sec. 77-1-11(1) of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, provides as follows, to-wit:

“It shall be unlawful for any public service commissioner, any candidate for public service commissioner, or money, campaign contribution or any emolument or other pecuniary benefit whatsoever, either directly or indirectly, from any person interested as owner, agent or representative, or from any person acting in any respect for such owner, agent or representative of any common or contract carrier by motor vehicle, telephone company, gas or electric utility company, or any other public utility that shall come under the jurisdiction or supervision of the Public Service Commission. Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this subsection shall be immediately forfeit his or her office or position and shall be fined not less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), imprisoned in the State Penitentiary for not less than one (1) year or both.”

5. Sec. 77-1-11(1) anticipates the very scenario which is involved in this case. It is unlawful for a Commissioner to “knowingly accept any . . . campaign contribution . . . *either directly or indirectly*, from any person interested as owner, agent or representative, or from *from any person acting in any respect for such owner, agent or representative of any electric utility company*, or any other public utility that shall come under the jurisdiction or supervision of the Public Service Commission.” (Emphasis supplied)
6. Each of the above contributors violated Sec. 77-1-11(1) by contributing to the 2013

Posey campaign and Commissioner Posey violated Sec. 77-1-11(1) by accepting these campaign contributions. In connection with the Kemper IGCC Project, the interest of each contributor was identical to the interests of Mississippi Power Co. Each contractor/contributor benefitted “directly or indirectly” from the continued financing and construction of Kemper IGCC. These contributors were, in fact, “acting for” Mississippi Power Company, creating a direct conflict of interest on the part of Commissioner Posey.

7. Also, Exhibit “C” shows that John Clay made a contribution of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) in 2013 on behalf of himself as a medical professional. Upon information and belief, Movant avers that John Clay is the husband of Beth Clay of the Clay Firm of Meridian, Mississippi which includes Mississippi Power Company as one of its clients (Exhibit “E”). Thus, John Clay, husband of a Mississippi Power Company lobbyist, made a contribution to the campaign of Lynn Posey, still another cog in the Posey-Mississippi Power Company conflict of interest.
8. The evidence is overwhelming that the contributors and Commissioner Posey acted “knowingly.” Whether viewed as a direct or indirect act, these contributions were made for the benefit of Mississippi Power Company and, obviously, for the benefit of the contributors themselves.
9. Even if the Commission were to conclude that there was no technical violation of the above statute, Commissioner Posey must recuse himself. His conflict of interest was no less significant. The contributions were still made for the same purpose. Each of the above contributors, including the “Chairmen,” had a direct and continuing interest in the

continued financing of the Kemper IGCC Project.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Intervener Blanton submits that Commissioner Lynn Posey should recuse himself in Docket No.: 2015-UN-80 for the reasons set forth hereinabove.

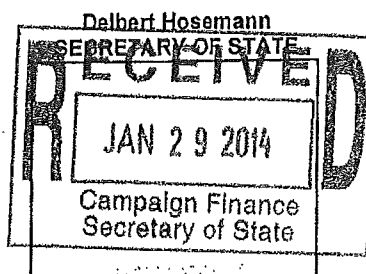

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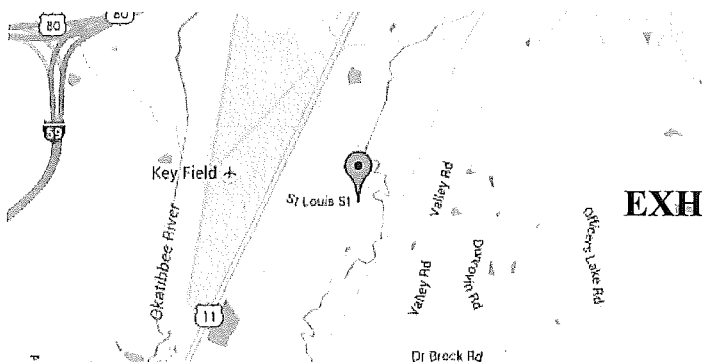

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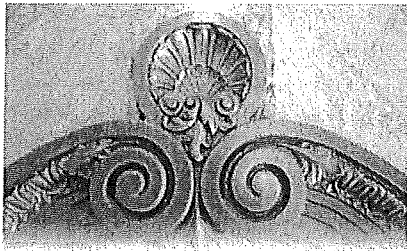
