Presley Announces \$30,000 Fine For Media Synergy Group, LLC For No-Call Violations

Jackson, Mississippi (January 11, 2012) – Public Service Commissioner Brandon Presley (D-Nettleton) announced today that the Mississippi Public Service Commission has fined Media Synergy Group, LLC of Richmond, Virginia, \$30,000 for violations of the Mississippi “No-Call” law and rules associated with enforcing the law.

Presley said Media Synergy Group, LLC violated the “No-Call” law by failing to register and purchase the State’s “No-Call” list and for contacting consumers that had registered on the “No-Call” list. Media Synergy Group, LLC also violated the “No-Call” law by utilizing an automated dialing system or a like system that uses a recorded voice message to communicate with the consumer.

Presley said the Commission is committed to stopping the solicitations which are a nuisance and an invasion of consumer’s privacy. Consumers can register to be on the Mississippi Do Not Call list at the Commission’s website (www.psc.state.ms.us) or by telephone at 800-356-6428.
