Public Service Commission Issues Letter to Mississippi Power Company to Begin Unveiling Process of Kemper Documents

[JACKSON, MISS]- Last month the Public Service Commission (Commission) issued a letter to Mississippi Power Company (MPCo) giving the company a deadline of thirty days to justify the confidential status of documents regarding the Kemper County Power Plant.

MPCo has since complied with this deadline and forwarded numerous documents to the Commission for review and will continue to submit documents in the coming days. The Commission began the process of unveiling confidential documents earlier this year and has since continued with its efforts in the original case that certificated the Kemper Project in 2010.

Law requires that companies be given the opportunity to identify and protect commercially and financially sensitive documents. However, if any documents are identified by MPCo as confidential, the company must justify its position to the Commission for any documents to remain confidential.

Any claim of confidentiality by MPCo will be reviewed by the Commission. In the case of a disagreement, the documents will be scheduled for release in which case MPCo may petition a court for a protective order.
