TESTIMONY OF DR. DAVID IRWIN, CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION, TO BE RELIED UPON AT HEARING

Lee County, by and through its Board of Supervisors, has operated and maintained the Turner Park Water and Sewer for The Community Development Foundation since the area was added through an order of the Public Service Commission granting a supplemental certificate of convenience and necessity on September 24, 1982.

The Community Development Foundation has never had ownership of any of the system's assets, nor has the Community Development Foundation shared in the financial performance of the system.

The Community Development Foundation desires to work with the Mississippi Public Service Commission and the Lee County Board of Supervisors to transfer the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity related to the Turner Park Water and Sewer system to the Lee County Board of Supervisors.

Having no financial interest in the system, the Community Development Foundation requests no compensation from the Lee County Board of Supervisors related to this transaction.
